


Discovery at Tenacre Workshop Series



“The Apostle Paul: Model for Transformation and Resolution”

Paul's transformation on the Damascus Road set him on a life course that continued for thirty years, sharing the Good News of Christ Jesus with the Gentiles throughout the Roman Empire. How can his life be a model for our own transformation and resolutions to continue sharing and living the teachings of Christ Jesus?

Friday night will be an overview of Paul's life, including a look at the first document of Christianity, I Thessalonians. Saturday morning we'll explore Galatians in depth and in the afternoon, investigate I Corinthians. What issues did Paul address in both congregations that are relevant to our church communities today? How do we bring these lessons forward? And what sustained Paul through the many challenges he faced? Bring your questions and insights and we'll explore these living letters together.
